- Use print writing only. Cursive writing can not be made into a quality font.
- Print the yellow lined page; write characters in the exact order as shown above. Use the yellow lines as a guide; this creates the baseline for your font.
- Use a black felt tip marker. Do not use pencil or a ball point pen. I recommend a black PaperMate medium tip pen.
- Keep all the letters the same angle as you usually write, this makes it more realistic.
- Be sure characters do not overlap.
- The quality of your handwriting font is directly related to the quality of the original characters.
